



First Trial to Canada Winter Games

Altadore Gymnastics Club, November 20th, 2010

WHO: **Athletes-** Must be a minimum of 12 years old as of January 1st, 2011 and a maximum of not having reached 19 years old as of January 1st, 2011. Born 1992 (except January 1st) to 1998 inclusive.

Excluded from Canada Winter Games:

- Athletes that have held C or senior cards (as defined by Sports Canada's Athlete Assistance Program) at any time;
- Athletes that have competed for any nation at any Senior Pan American Games, Commonwealth Games, Olympic Games, or Senior World Championships.

No athlete can be rendered ineligible within 90 days of the opening of the Games due to carding status (i.e., no athlete will be excluded if she is granted carding status after November 13th, 2010).

MEET FEE: \$75 per athlete
\$10 per athlete, for Elite Canada Screening Score Conversion

If registration AND payment have not been received by the stated deadline your registration may not be accepted. AGF authorizes a late registration and administration fee of \$20.00 per athlete.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: **Friday October 29th, 2010**

AWARDS: Top 8 All Around only

QUALIFICATIONS: ***First Trial will be worth 40% of final qualifying score**
***Second Trial will be worth 60% of final qualifying score**

Alberta Team Composition:

Top Seven (7) athletes will qualify to the Alberta Team (Combined score from 1st and 2nd trial)
One (1) athlete will qualify as an alternate to the Alberta Team, this athlete will attend training camps, but will not travel with the team to Halifax
Two (2) coaches will qualify as an Alberta Team member (one of whom must be female)

Note:

- *Medical petitions will be considered following the 2nd trial event to Canada Winter Games (January 8th, 2011). Officially an Alberta Team is not final until ratified by the Women's Program Committee*
- *Coaches attending CWG must be fully certified (Theory, technical, and practical) under the National Coaching Certification Program to at least Level 3 in Artistic Gymnastics. These coaches must be certified no later than ninety (90) days before the opening of the Games.*
