*The completed PRC and IRC must be received by the AGF office prior to the event/competition registration deadline.

* PRCs and IRCs are valid for a period of 3 years from the date of the completed PRC and IRC

* For coaches and volunteers who submitted a valid PRC and IRC in 2014, a new PRC and IRC will not be required until 2017

Judges by the Numbers:

- 52 registered judges:

Judging Courses:

- Red Deer introductory course cancelled due to low participation numbers
- National Course- October 10-12 Calgary
 - o 7 AB judges registered (+1 MB)
- Fast Track Course- November 13-15 Calgary (AGF office)
 - o Registration now open (deadline Oct. 28) to National athletes and former athletes, coaches, must be >16 yrs
- Possibility of another Calgary intro course and a request for an Edmonton intro course (fast track or other)
 - o Request for interest

Alberta Retreat:
