*The completed PRC and IRC must be received by the AGF office prior to the event/competition registration deadline.

* PRCs and IRCs are valid for a period of 3 years from the date of the completed PRC and IRC

* For coaches and volunteers who submitted a valid PRC and IRC in 2014, a new PRC and IRC will not be required until 2017

TRAINING CAMP RECAP

PROVINCIAL TUMBLING CAMP: ORTONA-November 18-19, 2016 (Athlete Focus)

- Training camp this last weekend in Edmonton
- 38 athletes from 8 clubs (ORT, PHO, EXE, EDG, CGC, PEG, AIR, CAR)
- First time using 4 different facilitators
- Janelle Desmarais-Moen, Derek Hanson, Eran Silberg, and Brandon O'Neil were the facilitators
- Focus on front tumbling, backsprings, blocking, and roundoffs

JUDGES REPORT

TTTC – November 22nd 2016

Judges Registration:

Registration is now Open until December 31, 2016.

Judges Re-Certification:

-Invitation

The goal will be to re-certify any judges for 1st Cup prior to the competition. Workshops will be run in Calgary and Edmonton in January. Exams will be ready in February. All judges need to re-certify by December 31, 2017 or will lose their certification.

We would like to host the workshops in gyms if possible! Please let me know if your gym is available to host the clinic in a board room and some in gym practice with judging horizontal displacement (the alternative is using video which is always harder to judge than real people)

Retreat:

Thank you to the ATTSA for supporting our judges at this year's retreat.

Implementations from Retreat Discussion:

- **Changes to the composition of panels and number of judges – discussion on practicality and placement of new judge roles**
- **Addition of 30 cm platforms for the tumbling and DMT panels- possibility of renting? Building?**
- **Addition of another volunteer to support the DD judge when using minimum panels**
- **Volunteer Scorers to flash total score and DD score?**
- **Invitational judges cost- flat rate for provincial and national judges to assist in affordability for invitational judges**

Upcoming Judging Season:

New Code of Points

- Finalization of FIG rules will come out following the Intercontinental course the first week of Feb.

Upcoming FIG Course

- 1 AB judge confirmed for the Intercontinental Course in February
- An additional 5 applicants for the FIG course in Toronto in March

Judge Outreach- A group of national judges is working on putting together a presentation of the new rules to take to clubs for athlete and coach education. This will be available to all interested clubs.
